Dear friends,

This is the week after the celebration of our Lord's resurrection. I have a deep love for the worship services of Holy Week, both Maundy Thursday and Good Friday followed with the wondrous good news of Easter morning. During this time I consistently find my hopes being renewed. I am reminded of the words I heard some years ago about being Easter people in a Good Friday world.

If ever we needed to walk with the bright light of hope burning deeply in our hearts it is now. All one has to do is listen to the evening news and it is easy to become discouraged. The terrorist attacks in Brussels remind us of how dangerous parts of the world are. Some areas of our country have seen intensive flooding, other areas are experiencing extreme drought. Far too many people are underemployed. Each night we hear news of the continuing war in Syria and Iraq. We realize how much we need to pray for peace to come to these war torn countries, all the people who have been displaced because of war and for the safety of our troops.

There were perhaps no people who were more dispirited and anxious than the disciples who gathered in the upper room after the death of Jesus. To them the future appeared completely hopeless. My prayer is that you and I, especially when we feel discouraged that we will remember that our Lord Jesus also desires to come to us and to say to our lagging spirits "Peace be with you." We need to allow the God of all hope to restore hope in our lives, to revive our spirits and to re-assure us that everything is going to be fine. And then we need to get back into the business of life, bringing that same sense of hope to those with whom we work and love.
