Dear friends,

We are in the season of Epiphany, the season of light. It is the time, in the life of the church, that we remember that Jesus is the light that shines in our darkness, a light no darkness can ever overcome. It is during this season that we, as fellow believers in Christ, are reminded time and again through the miracles of Jesus and stories of His healing and forgiving encounters with people of his day that He is the Son of God, who has taken on flesh and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth.

Some of the miracle stories we hear include Jesus changing water in wine at the wedding of Cana in Galilee, walking on the sea of Galilee and helping Peter to also walk, very briefly, on water, as well as stories of Jesus healing the sick, the blind, the deaf, the paralyzed and raising the dead. Each story is there to remind us that Jesus is God's Son, and that He has the power to bring light into whatever darkness has either descended upon us or that we have discovered within us. The light Jesus brings is the light of forgiving, healing love. It is that peace which passes all understanding, that recovery of hope when all of life seems full of despair, the joy of knowing that nothing will ever separate us from his love.

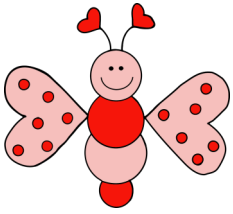

Have a wonderful February!

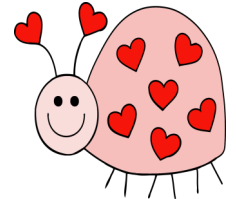

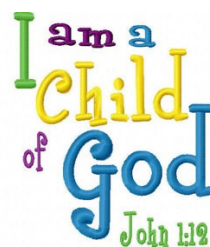
Faith Sunday School
