The verses in Matthew continue, “And can any of you by worrying add a single hour to your span of life?” and later verse 34; “So do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring worries of its own. Today’s trouble is enough for today.” I need to remind myself to “let go and let God”.

To close I would like to share a prayer (author unknown) that we pray and is so very comforting for us;

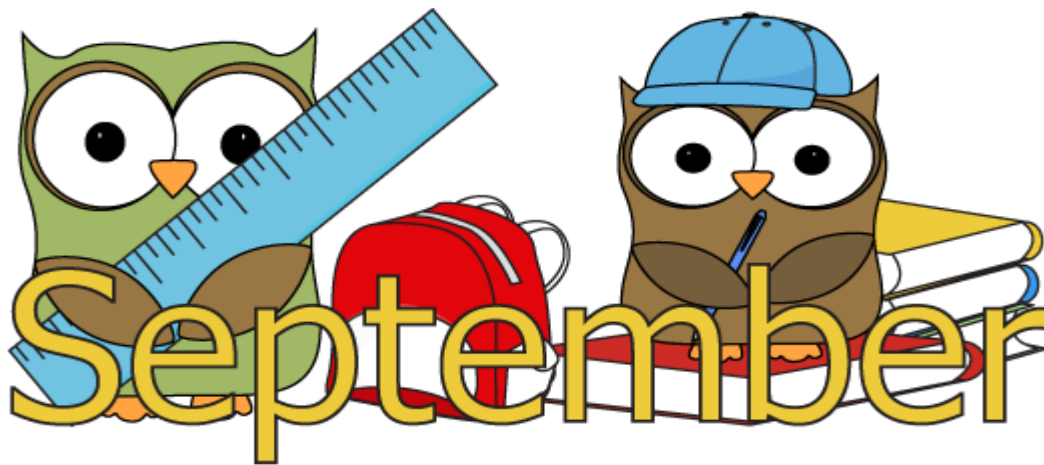
Dear God, as I lay me down to sleep, relax the tension of my body;

- \*Attend Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and 3 Lenten Worship services.
- \*Students will pick and meet with a Mentor to complete a packet that Pastor Gordy has prepared. More information will be provided during Confirmation class.
- \*Acolyting is a requirement for Confirmation students. A schedule is listed in each months newsletter. If you are unable to acolyte on your scheduled Sunday it is your responsibility to exchange with someone else.
