Dear friends,

Peter Marshall wrote, "we yearn, our Father, for the simple beauty of Christmas----for all the old familiar melodies and words that remind us of that great miracle when God, who had made all things, was one night to become as a babe, to lie in the crook of a woman's arm."

Christmas is the baby Jesus in a Bethlehem stable, surrounded by sheep and oxen, worshipped by Shepherds, and cradled in Mary and Joseph's arms.

Christmas is meant to be simple and beautiful. It is a time to remind us of God reaching out to tell His children of His love in the most personal way possible, by becoming one of us, sharing His love that will never fail you, but will in every way uphold and sustain you. May our Lord and Savior bless each of you and your loved one.!!!
