Dear friends,

We celebrated Reformation Sunday followed by All Saints Sunday. It is because of the Reformation that the Holy Scriptures were finally made available to ordinary lay people. It was also at this time that many of our wonderful hymns were first penned. Part of those Scriptures include the Passion Narrative, our Lord Jesus dying on the Cross and then Easter morning when the final enemy, which is death, was forever overcome. What gifts that you and I have been given!

We will also soon be celebrating Thanksgiving. And as every November in the past I have had one of those old hymns coursing through my mind. The hymn is a familiar one, you can count on singing it at our Thanksgiving service. It is named, "Come, You Thankful People Come." This hymn was written by a fellow named Henry Alford, who based the words on Psalm 95:2, "Let us come into God's presence with thanksgiving: Let us shout joyfully to Him with Psalms." Remember this verse with me. "Come, you thankful people come; Raise the song of harvest home. All is safely gathered in, Ere the winter storms begin. God, our Maker doth provide, for our wants to be supplied: Come to God's own temple come; Raise the song of harvest home." I know that the singing of this hymn this year will come with less vigor than in past years. This is because, we have truly had a difficult fall with too much rain and wind. Instead of combines running on solid ground they are moving through mud and water. It's certainly a time of challenge for our farmers and our rural communities which work hand in hand with our farmers to keep the harvest goina.

Although not all of us are farmers, we, like those who farm, are also people of the land. We watch the rhythms of seed time and harvest. We know the time should be coming when the machinery will be parked for a few months as the snows come blowing and the wind whistling around us. But this year, as more than one farmer has told me, "we might be combining at Thanksgiving and still drying our crops over the Christmas holidays."

At times like this it's important to share our frustrations, find someone, even your Pastor to vent to, and to never lose heart that God will provide for us and our families. These conversations, along with the faithful presence of our God who is always near to give us strength and courage for our journeys will carry each of us through the future no matter what issues we may be dealing with. So, in spite of everything that is proving so difficult we still have much to be thankful for, family, friends, a listening ear, and our God who sends His Holy Spirit to comfort and reassure.
