Dear friends,

"There is a passage from the book of Isaiah which gives voice to a powerful prayer---that God would enter this world with divine power and promise. "O that you would tear open the heavens and come down," the prophet cries. This Advent, as we prepare our hearts and our homes to receive the Christ child, we should remember that God has entered time, space and human existence—that God has torn open the heavens and is remaking our world from the ground up, the way a potter starts with a lump of clay and eventually creates a beautiful vessel. God is doing a new thing---can we perceive it?" This passage from an Advent devotional I read was written by Carol Jacobson, an associate professor of theology at Pacific Lutheran University.

I love Isaiah's question. It is filled with a deep sense of yearning for God to enter this world of ours with all of its times of crises and danger, sorrow and pain, and those welcome times of joy and hope that come from time to time to renew our hope, faith and courage.

Isaiah's prayer is answered centuries later in the birth of the Christ child. It is in this birth that the work of redemption is begun, the work of remaking our world from the ground up. And that God's work begins from the ground up is signified by having our Lord born to the poorest of the poor, his birth heralded to shepherds who were near the very bottom of Israel' social order and Jesus' ministry of healing, especially to those considered outside of God's favor, the poor, the sick, the oppressed, and those labeled sinners by the religious establishment. God does His work of rebuilding our world not through force, but through the power of love, compassion and the seeking of justice and life for all peoples across the planet.


Gerhard Frost once wrote that we live on glimpses of God's reshaping and remaking this broken world, something which will never be completed this side of Christ's second coming. To me, whenever I see another person engaged in an act of kindness or generosity or witnessing to the hope Christ Jesus has established in their hearts. I also see it in acts like the Berlin wall being torn down, or when Nelson Mandela instituted a truth and reconciliation commission instead of a policy of revenge to bring healing and not more division when he came into power in his racially torn country. In these events; I am witnessing one of those glimpses Dr. Frost was referring to.

The message of Advent and Christmas is that God is indeed present in our world in our individual lives reshaping the world and reshaping us into being more and more the people God created us to be. Like the potter trying to shape a bowl out of a lump of clay. It takes

time, patience and an immense heart of love to not give up on the stubborn lumps we as nations and individuals can sometimes prove to be.

My prayer is that you and I will have a continuous prayer. "Come Lord Jesus, come quickly and make me and our entire creation new." Have a wonderful Advent and Christmas.


#### F.A.M.I.L.Y. Faith and Mooreton incredible Lutheran Youth
