
All are invited to attend, including family and friends of our Sunday School students.

Dear Family of Faith Lutheran & Mooreton Lutheran,

As I write this letter to you, Thanksgiving is just around the corner and Christmas is fast approaching. I remember my parents lamenting that the older they got, the faster time went. Wow, but that is reality for me now. The hours and days just fly by!

I have appreciated the reprieve we've had from that first early snow and take note of each day where the temps have been above freezing and I still have green grass in my yard even though it is covered by at least a million beautiful oak leaves! This year the season of Advent begins on December 3rd and continues the following 3 Sundays. This year is unique in that the fourth Sunday falls on Christmas Eve. This occurs only about every 6 or 7 years. Every year in our churches we hang an Advent wreath with 4 candles to symbolize each Sunday of the Advent season. The lighting of these candles are a tradition I love. The meaning associated with each candle varies depending on which resource you use. One that I like is #1-phrophecy or hope, #2-faith #3-joy, #4-peace or love.

However, you choose to celebrate each candle, I encourage you to have an Advent wreath in your home. It doesn't have to be elaborate. A simple circle of four candles, taking a few minutes of family time on each Sunday with the lighting of a candle, and talking about how it is meant to prepare our hearts for Jesus's birthday can create memories and meaning for all of us. For the young ones, it can help them realize that Christmas is more than presents. For us older folks, it helps keep us focused on this sacred event of Jesus's birth. Yes, there are so many events to celebrate this Christmas season, but sometimes the simplest things like using an Advent wreath can create lasting memories for every age.

My prayer for each of you in this Holy season is that you will keep in your hearts the miracle. of this tiny babe coming to earth to live among us, model how-to live-in love and make the sacrifice of dying on a cross for our sins. The ultimate gift to us, His resurrection.

Our family wishes each of you a blessed Christmas.

Dear friends,

I am writing this brief note to share some news that is very difficult for Wallyn and me to address. You may have noticed my absence from the pulpit on past Sundays and I think you deserve an explanation.

Some of you may have heard me say that after Wallyn and I returned from our trip to the Holy Land, and I had my second bout with Covid, I just could not get over being tired all the time.

My brother Alan said, "if you are experiencing what I am; it's like you can't get your oomph back." It wasn't until I visited my doctor for my annual physical and he said, "Pastor Lee, your hemoglobin is really low." I asked if that could explain my constant battle with fatigue. He responded, "Absolutely. You are bleeding somewhere and we need to find where that is." He set me up for a colonoscopy and an endoscopy which would enable a specialist to look at my esophagus. During the procedure he found a cancerous lesion and referred me for surgery the following Monday.

The surgeon removed, what proved to be, a cancerous mass at the "distal end of my esophagus." He also checked my lymph nodes and sent the material in for examination.

The result looks promising. He appears to have gotten all the cancer out and is going to be doing a form of radiation therapy beginning in a few weeks. He told me that I needed to rest and give my body a chance to begin the healing process. I have also been set up to meet with an oncologist who will assist my surgeon in keeping an eye on the healing process and is going to try to understand why there are some abnormalities with my red blood cells, problems which are leading to my continuing sense of fatigue.

This has served as a "wake-up" call for me and led me to decide, with input from Wallyn and our children, to retire from my call to Mooreton Lutheran and Faith Lutheran on January 31, 2024.

It has been a difficult time in my life, but I believe it is what God is calling me to do. I feel incredibly blessed to have served here since February 4, 2004. I feel deeply connected to each of you and your families. I have been honored to baptize your children, confirm so many young people in their faith in the Risen Christ, perform many weddings and so many funerals of our loved ones.

I haven't made this decision easily; but I believe it is in the best interests of our congregations and myself as we journey into our futures.

Know you will always be in my prayers, as well as Wallyn's. God bless you and thank you for your call to be your pastor these many years.
