Dear friends,

A close friend of mine once gave me a plaque with the following prayer printed on it, a prayer known as the serenity prayers and written by Reinhold Niebuhr. I share it for the following reasons.

I know that for some of our families this summer has been filled with stressors. The stressors may be different; where one family is dealing with heartache and grief, another might be dealing with financial insecurities or worried about their children who, though grown and mature, are wrestling with work or family issues. For our farm families the way the rain comes and covers acres of crops, and it doesn't even rain 2 miles away can be very depressing.

Life can and often is difficult in the best of times. Recognizing this reality, Niebuhr wrote: "God grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change; courage to change the things I can; and wisdom to know the difference."

A few years ago, I shared the fact that in addition to these words there are more words to the prayer. I thought I would share them with you again. "Living one day at a time; enjoying one moment at a time; accepting hardships as the pathway to peace; taking, as He did, this sinful world as it is, not as I would have it; trusting that He will make all things right if I surrender to His Will; that I may be reasonably happy in this life and supremely happy with Him forever in the next. Amen.

I invite you to read it two or three times. As you do certain phrases will probably arrest your attention as they have mine. At any rate, whether we are trying to make personal decisions, worried about the harvest or trying to deal with some health issues, I hope this prayer helps.
