

Dear friends,

One of my favorite memories from childhood is coloring pictures depicting scenes of the first Pilgrims celebrating Thanksgiving. I remember tying to color within the lines, making certain the Pilgrim men had black hats and black clothes while the women wore colorful dresses. I loved coloring the turkeys, who were still alive and not aware that they were about to become part of the celebration. And I recall trying to color the Native Americans with their brown skin and vibrant feathers fastened to their heads while they held out gifts of corn and venison. It is one of those memories that never ceases to bring me a sense of joy.

The first Thanksgiving, in the sense of it being "a public celebration acknowledging divine favors" dates October 1621, by Plymouth Colony Pilgrims in appreciation of assistance from members of the Massasoit tribe and celebration of the first harvest); though Thanksgiving Day itself is not attested to until 1670.

At the end of this month we will once again engage as families and friends to thank God for all of the blessings we enjoy. Blessings including our families, friends, a roof over our heads and food for our stomachs. On the Tuesday evening before Thanksgiving , we will celebrate with a Worship service and will praise God for all of his gifts.

While our tendency is to focus on the benefits of living here, with the ability to provide for our families; our main focus must never wander from the greatest blessing we have received, the blessing of God sending His Son to deliver us from sin, death and the power of the devil. 




