Dear friends,

WOW! We actually had a spring this year; we didn't move directly from bitter cold to hot sunny days. The transition has been wonderful. Rains have come after a long dry winter with lots of cold and dreary days and the valley is lush and green. Garage sales are in full force, baseball teams are in full swing, people are walking around in T shirts and shorts, and garden plants are starting to emerge from the dark rich soils. Truly we are blessed. Blessed to watch as through processes invisible to the naked eye, our trees bud and leaf out, lilacs bloom with a perfume scent not available in any story that I know of, and as the crops grow, even though we know the process of seeding fertilizing as well as spraying for those pesky weeks has and will occur, we still marvel at the invisible process taking place before our eyes. A process where a tiny seeds open and send roots into the soil and a stem pointing towards the heavens. A process where over time these seeds will yield stalks that contain many more seeds, the plants will mature to a beautiful golden or green and another harvest will be underway.

Last Sunday I spoke about how the Holy Spirit works in much the same way in our lives. As St. Paul says in Galatians regarding the planting of house churches; I planted, Apollos planted, but God gave the growth. In the same way God is constantly at work growing the faith that is within us. Silently, slowly, through days when the skies of our lives seem sunny and through the days the skies of our lives seem to be filled with foreboding clouds and winds. Where our crops and gardens grow through a combination of soil, sun and rain, God grows our faith through our hearing the Word of God proclaimed and read. God grows our faith each time we receive our Lord Jesus in, with and under the bread and the wine. God grows our faith each time we reach out to help a brother or sister in need. Sometimes this is by giving food to go to the food pantry, or sending quilts and layettes to people in third world countries. Sometimes it as simple as a phone call, a card, an e-mail or a hug.

When you look at the crops grow you never see just one stalk of wheat growing alone, unless a seed has somehow been blown into a field by mistake. No, instead every plant is surrounded by hundreds and thousands of others. God doesn't want us to try and grow alone in our faith either. That is why God has called us into communities of believers where our faith can be nurtured and where our witness can lend strength to others. This summer, wherever you might be, I hope you take time to worship together. If you don't make it to church, share some prayers around a campfire and sing some of those

Bible Camp or Vacation Bible School songs you remember. God's Spirit works in those times as well growing your faith and creating memories that will last a lifetime.

Be safe, every day remember God's unconditional love for you and yours. Have a blessed summer!!
